The Oaklea Trust. Who are we?

The Oaklea Trust is a registered charity with a vision of a society where individuals are enabled to be effective citizens irrespective of age, disability or disadvantage.

The mission of the Oaklea Trust is

- to support individuals to achieve their aspirations through care, education and development; encouraging independence and maximising capabilities
- to support communities to maximise their impact upon the lives of beneficiaries and value to society

The Oaklea Trust supports young people to live independently either in shared or individual accommodation. The work we do with young people and their families ensures that individuals achieve their aspirations. Sometimes these can be simple things like being fit and healthy. Being an active member of the local community or developing new skills to enable independent living, training or work can also be achieved with Oaklea's help.

The Oaklea Trust supports older adults with services ranging from care and support in the home, to supporting individuals to continue to access their communities and encourage social interactions and friendships to blossom.

The Oaklea Trust supports communities in various ways. For example through organising community groups and clubs and helping them to operate effectively, building skills and confidence in those with a disability or other disadvantage and supporting employers to understand the benefits of employing an individual with a disability or perceived disadvantage. Building bridges and finding ways for communities to connect and work better together.

Making a Will

Making a will helps to explain to your family and friends what you want to happen to your estate after your death. Family and friends are really important to you and making a will ensures that your money and possessions go to the people you love after you're gone.

It is advisable to ask for help from a specialist in the writing of wills, for example a solicitor. They will be able to give proper advice on the appointment of executors and ensure the legal validity of your will.
